



## My dear friends,

I'm writing this letter to inform you that I'll be starting a one year internship this September with Youth Unlimited (also known as Youth for Christ). I'm very excited to begin this new ministry opportunity. I humbly ask for your support. Youth Unlimited staff and interns are expected to fundraise their salaries through partnerships with churches and individuals, so it is my humble ask that you might partner with me for this journey. More important still, I would also ask that you partner with me in your prayers, that I may grow in this internship, serve effectively, and that the will of God will be fulfilled in my life, and the lives of those with whom I interact.

To provide you more details into my internship, here is an overview of what I will be doing. Throughout a fifteen hour work week, my responsibilities will include working as an assistant leader in different YU Youth programs, participating in biweekly intern peer support cohort meetings, investing in my own spiritual growth and development, participating in various workshops and training sessions, and fundraising my support for the year internship.

My goals and desires for this internship are to move towards working in ministry full time with Youth Unlimited, to grow spiritually in my faith, and to discover where God is leading me within Youth Unlimited.

I am deeply grateful for the opportunity that this internship represents, as I have grown so much through my years at Youth Unlimited, but still have a passion to grow more.
